

Tequila Glossary

Agave

What tequila is made from. It's not a cactus but a member of the lily family and only blue agave may be used for tequila and all of our tequilas are made from 100% blue agave unless otherwise indicated.

Añejos

At a minimum añejos get 1 year of aging in wood and some receive more than 5 years. This treatment results in a flavor profile comparable with fine scotch and cognac.

Blancos

Are also known as white, silver or plata, blancos are aged a maximum of 30 days and offer the best pure expression of blue agave flavor.

Joven Abocado

This is blanco tequila with caramel coloring added to give it an aged appearance and create the ubiquitous gold tequila sold all over the world but rarely seen in Mexico.

Licores

Sweet, tequila based liqueurs, infused with various special flavors.

Highland Tequila

These tequilas from the highlands northeast of Guadalajara and tend to have a "fruity" character.

Lowland Tequila

Tequilas from this area southwest of Guadalajara, surrounding the town of Tequila, generally have more wood and earth flavors than Los Altos products.

Mezcal

All tequila is mezcal, just as all cognac is brandy: Tequila and its surroundings are actually a place where famous mezcals are made. Most top quality mezcals come from the area around Oaxaca in southern Mexico.

Mixtos

These tequilas are made from 51% blue agave and okay for a margarita or a traditional salt-shot-lime routine but the quality of this style of tequila is certainly inferior to those made with 100% agave.

Reposados

These smooth, golden hued tequilas are aged in wood for 2–12 months and are excellent for sipping.

Super Añejos

These special añejos are wood-aged a minimum of 3 years. The prolonged ageing slowly transforms a tequila añejo into a drink they say is 'dressed in tails.'

Tequila

Tequila is produced mostly in the western Mexican state of Jalisco. There are two key areas, the lowlands, close to the town of Tequila, 56 km to the west of the city of Guadalajara and Los Altos, or the highlands around the same distance to the northeast.

Lowland Tequilas

Arette

Made at a small distillery near the town of Tequila owned by a portion of the Orendain family.

(26658) Arette Blanco

Colorless with moderate candied agave aromas. Dry and astringent in the mouth, it has some earthy, dusty agave flavor that quickly fades into an astringent finish.

(26586) Arette Reposado

Lightly smoky nose, ultra-smooth palate, 4 – 6 months bourbon aged.

Cabo Wabo

Sammy Hagar, sometime front-man for rock group Van Halen, owns the company that makes Cabo Wabo, which was named after his famous nightclub in Cabo San Lucas in Baja California. Perhaps surprisingly the Red Rocker makes excellent tequila that has garnered glowing reviews and a winner of best of show from the American Tasting Institute.

(26526) Cabo Wabo Blanco

Unaged 100% agave tequila that makes a great margarita or sip it straight and taste for notes of fruit and pepper.

(26527) Cabo Wabo Reposado

Aged 4 to 6 months in oak casks for a smoother, richer flavor.

Loads of agave flavor with oak notes and hints of pepper and caramel.

Casa Noble

Founded in the 1700s as a hacienda, Casa Noble was one of tequila's largest producers in 1900 and now makes only top-quality 100% agave tequilas.

(26553) Casa Noble Crystal

A double gold medal winner at the San Francisco World Spirits competition that is triple distilled in the town of Tequila.

(26554) Casa Noble Reposado

A wonderfully refined tequila that is smooth, sensuous and full-bodied, a rival to the best spirits in the world.

A limited production item, this tequila is matured in French White Oak barrels for five years, giving it a deep golden tone and an exceptional bouquet and body.

Don Eduardo

The premium brand of Orendain, one of Mexico's 4 largest tequila producers.

(26566) Don Eduardo Añejo

Made from estate grown agave and aged in used bourbon barrels.

Jose Cuervo

Owned by the giant British drinks company Daigeo, Cuervo is the world's largest producer of tequila and has over 40 million agave plants under cultivation.

(26677) Cuervo 1800 Silver

Soft aroma of fruit, floral and agave. Delicate, balanced and smooth with a medium finish. Watch out for gold-colored highlights in Silver.

(26501) Cuervo 1800 Añejo

A premium tequila aged in new French oak barrels, it is full of agave aromas and has nice body and excellent wood character – very smooth and slightly sweet in the style typical of Cuervo.

Partida

The Partida family lands lie outside the village of Amatitan, in the shadow of a dormant volcano. For nearly a century, they have tilled the rich, red soil. Because the Partidas control their lands, they control the quality of their tequila in a way few others can.

(26669) Partida Blanco

Brilliant, clean and crisp. Very floral with notes of citrus, fresh herbs and tropical fruit. Well balanced with a natural, pure agave flavor and a pleasant finish that lingers gently on the palate.

(26670) Partida Reposado

Aged 6 months in French Canadian oak. Aromas of vanilla, hazelnut and almond with a deep rich finish.

Aged 19 months. A fruity aroma with notes of cherry, almond, dried fruit and spices. Soft honey fruited tones, with flavors of banana, chocolate and sweet pear with a spectacular finish.

Regional

Regional has been producing tequila since the mid 1970's but has only recently begun to promote its own brand.

(26653) Regional Silver

Smooth mouthfeel and nice agave character.

(26539) Regional Reposado

Good agave character with smoky notes from 4 months of aging in used bourbon barrels.

Strong but mellow, with marcho intensity and suave complexity. This tequila is loaded with earthy agave and caramelized aromas with moderate citrus notes.

Sauza

One of the famous tequila brands. Check out our tequila mural that is a reproduction of one that hangs at the Sauza distillery.

(26511) Sauza Hornitos

Strong, mellow attack, with moderate agave complexity. Caramel and pepper aromas followed by citrus and lilac. Sweet and full in the mouth. Aftertaste is long and tingly with just a hint of mint and smoky bitterness from 3 months of aging. One of the tequila's best values for 100% blue agave. 750 ml Bottle 288.99, BIG SHOT 19.99, Shot 12.99

(26612) Sauza Tres Generaciones Plata

Named for the 3 generations of the family that built this famous brand, this tequila goes by the nickname of Three G's. Stoney palate. Touch of mint.

(26657) Sauza Tres Generaciones Reposado

Superbly crafted, perfectly balanced, and extremely versatile, Tres Generaciones Reposado is made of 100% hand-picked, pure blue agave and is rested for three months exclusively in double-treated American Oak barrels.

(26641) Sauza Triada Añejo

Hand-crafted and perfectly balanced, this is the only añejo tequila that starts as a reposado before receiving additional aging in small oak bourbon barrels. These barrels are decharred by hand to impart a rich, wood essence.

Other Lowland Tequilas

(26634) Orendain Ollitas Reposado

Meaning 'little pots' this tequila has a full and distinctive flavor of vanilla, caramel and perky spices.

Cazadores

The flavor of Cazadores Tequila reflects its excellence.

(26629) Cazadores Blanco

This Blanco glides smoothly over the most demanding palates and delights the most refined tastes.

(26663) Cazadores Añejo

Aged no less than 12 months, in new, small, American white oak barrels. Notes of cinnamon, vanilla, nut, and pear can also be detected, lending it a subtly sweet, rich flavor.

Centinela

Centinela is produced in the Los Altos town of Arandas by a family-owned company that has made tequila since 1894.

(26630) Centinela Reposado

Aged 4 months in American white oak. Shows soft fruit and cinnamon flavor. Slightly sweet with a medium mouth feel. The finish has a little bitterness and some sweetness.

Corazon

Produced in an ultramodern distillery set in a famous tequila growing area near Arandas. The Espolon brand also is made in this distillery.

(26547) Corazon Blanco

This blanco was ranked first in tastings by the Beverage Testing Institute of Chicago with a score of 93. The BTI review reads, "Clear. Lush spicy agave nose. Medium-full body. Substantial mouth feel. Rich, smooth agave palate with delicate pineapple fruit notes and a surprising peppery snap at the finish."

(26548) Corazon Reposado

The aged version of the blanco is very highly rated by reviewers. From the makers of Espolon.

An exceptionally elegant and flavorful tequila with notes of citrus and vanilla.

(26648) Corzo Reposado

Ages in small white oak barrels for additional smoothness and flavor. It combines the elegance of Corzo Silver with hints of oak and honey.

Don Julio

Now owned by Jose Cuervo, Don Julio is one of the worlds most respected and sought after brands.

(26515) Don Julio Blanco

This tequila comes straight out of distillation into bottles. It shows a bit of sweetness and some vanilla notes as if it had seen some wood aging and a bit of herbaceous and spicy qualities as well.

(26516) Don Julio Reposado

Delicate agave, caramel and floral aromas with hints of pepper and lemon. Low sweetness and medium body. Agave, apple and caramel flavors plus traces of pepper and dried flowers. Finish is hot and long-lasting. After taste is a complex combination of agave, smoke and caramel. One of the great tequilas.

(26517) Don Julio 1942

Comes in a great, agave-shaped bottle that contains one of the finest tequilas made by Julio González Estrada who is amongst the most esteemed makers of super-premium tequila.

(26518) Don Julio Real Añejo

One of the most extraordinary sipping tequilas in the world. This is a special blend produced in very limited quantities. It entices the palate with notes of caramel, chocolate and toffee, unfolding into a long, sensuous finish. This is our most expensive and lavish tequila.

We proudly feature El Charro products because of their excellent quality and great value.

(26523) El Charro Reposado

A great value made in a relatively new distillery by a highly respected *tequilero*. Shows *macho* intensity, earthy agave aromas and a bit of sweetness. The first flavor to hit is caramel, closely followed by agave, pepper and oak.

Small batches, triple distillation and 2 years in French oak barrels make this a wonderfully smooth and balanced tequila.

This is one of the world's great distillers. Located in Arandas, El Tesoro is about as artisanal as a producer can be and still employs a donkey to crush the agaves, which are all fermented in open wooden vats then distilled to 80%. El Tesoro is one of the few producers that never "cuts" their tequila with water.

(26651) El Tesoro Silver

Crystal clear with a big smoky nose, this tequila has muchos pantelones in agave intensity. It has a sweet thick flavor with pepper and citrus, and is hot with a medium finish.

(26550) El Tesoro Reposado

Aged 9 months in new, white-oak barrels, there is a robust nose, revealing subtle oak and vanilla mellowed from the softness of barrel aging. This is an awesome tequila, definitely one of the best.

(26551) El Tesoro de Añejo

Another exceptional tequila from El Tesoro, which is aged 2-3 years to give a luxuriously rich product with a minty character and a harmonious balance of oak and fruity agave.

Naturally fermented for up to four days. The agave juices are then double-distilled in antique copper stills and bottled un-aged. Smooth, orangy smell with a spicy taste.

Aged after fermentation in American Oak casks for six to nine months before bottling. Smooth and smoky, with saline, herbal and vegetal aromas.

Made in the highland town of Zaptlanejo in a distillery owned by Jose Cuervo, Gran Centenario is an definitely a top-flight tequila.

This small production super-premium sees a bit of wood aging in new, white oak casks to give it a lovely smoothness for a blanco.

(26520) Gran Centenario Reposado

This is a top of the range product and even at a rather hefty price it is great value for the excellent taste and complexity.

Milagro mean miracle in Spanish and this tequila is triple-distilled, hand-crafted product that sees extended aging.

An artisanal brand made by the Garibay family outside the small town of Jesus Maria.

Very dry, light to medium-bodied with smoky roasted pepper and spice notes.

(26635) Oro Azul Reposado

This is a pale yellow tequila with a big agave intensity and lots of complexity. The nose is filled with agave, pineapple, caramel and spice. The flavors are a mixture of pear, agave and smoke.

(26559) Oro Azul Añejo

Aging over two years in charred oak barrels give this tequila a deep vanilla and pickling spice nose. The round entry leads to an off-dry, medium body with sweet toffee, brown spice, salt, leather, tobacco and green pepper flavors. It finishes gracefully with a fruity, agave-driven notes.

Patrón

Patrón is produced and blended in a facility high in the mountains of Jalisco. It is one of America's most recognized and prized labels of super-premium tequila.

Aromas of agave, herbs, pepper and the sea, dry and spicy on the attack with a strong agave and pepper presence and a pleasant aftertaste reminiscent of tobacco.

(26676) Gran Patrón Platinum

Triple distilled then aged to perfection, it is a true connoisseur's silver tequila. The agave is pruned, steam baked, triple distilled and aged to provide a superior taste. Every Gran Patrón bottle is a handmade crystal (lead free) piece of art that is hand polished, hand signed and numbered with an etched label.

(26546) Cabrito Blanco

Strong and mellow on the attack with moderate agave intensity, some fruit character and a hint of pepper and chamomile on the finish.

Chinaco

Chinaco is a super-premium brand made by the Gonzales family that pioneered the growing of Weber Blue Agave in the northern state of Tamaulipas when the practice was made legal in 1973.

Bottled within 30 days after distillation. Pear, quince, dill and lime with a touch of aloe. Clean, smooth, fresh and bright taste.

Carefully aged 3 years in government-sealed and certified oak barrels. Rich amber golden color. Aromas of pear, wild flowers, vanilla and baked apple. Rich, complex, great depth and balance with a heavily wooded taste.

(26664) Chinaco 30th Year Super Añejo

For its age, flavor, color and bouquet, this tequila is considered to be a treasure for collectors and connoisseurs.

Corralejo

From the Mexican state of Guanajuato, this distillery uses copper stills and traditional methods exclusively. There is some controversy about Corralejo because although it makes a 100% agave product and not all designations are made from 100% Weber Blue Agave so these bottles by law cannot say 100% agave on their labels. Taste it and decide for yourself whether it stacks up with other super-premium products.

(26540) Corralejo Blanco

Traditional production methods yield an unique and complex tequila.

Del Maguey

Del Maguey is under the guidance of American artist Ron Cooper who has done much to promote mezcal, its history, production and culture. Cooper insists on only traditional methods, without additives or blending. His single-village producers use 100% agave espadin and make some of the world's best mezcals. Del Maguey products are highly praised and truly worthy of being called super-premium.
